The Parent Project was created by a team of teachers, psychologists, law enforcement officers, and above all **Parents**!! The course is designed to meet the specific needs of parents raising strong willed or out-of-control adolescents. It is unique because it focuses on the prevention and suppression of the most destructive of adolescent behaviors.

Parent Project Philosophy

The vast majority of parents love and care about their children.

Parents are an essential key to successful children.

When given skills and the necessary support, parents can and will make the difference.

The Parent Project Curriculum was created to...

1. Help parents demonstrate their love for their children
2. Allow parents to experience early success
3. Encourage parents to stay with the process
4. Teach intervention/prevention strategies for:
 - School attendance and performance
 - Drug and alcohol use
 - Negative peer association
 - Violence and bullying
5. Improve parent/child relationship
6. Offer ongoing emotional and practical support for families

What's Involved?

- A ten week course
- One evening per week for three hours
- Dinner will be provided
- A homework assignment each week
- A parent manual to write in and keep
- A certificate of completion at the end of the course
- Cost is \$5.00 due at intake
