- **Take a *spring hike*.** Explore Fairfield County's many parks, fairgrounds, or nature Sundays from 1:00pm-4:00pm all of April and May.
- **Community Easter Egg Hunts-** Check your local communities for dates and time for annual Easter egg hunts.
- **Alley Park After Dark**, April 26 from 7:00pm-9:00pm- Join Outdoor Educators for a fun evening in the park after dark! Play nocturnal games, take a hike, and make a *s'more*. The hike is moderately paced involving 2+ miles & uneven terrain. Closed toed shoes and a hiking stick are suggested.
- Alley Park's **What's Bloomin Hike** April 27 from 10:00am-11:30am- Meet in the front parking lot at Alley Park at 10am. Your hike leader will take you on an adventure in the park looking for flowers blooming to date. The hike will be of moderate pace involving 2+ miles & uneven terrain. Closed toed shoes and a hiking stick are suggested.
- Fairfield County Job and Family Services is hosting **Circus Night**, Thursday, April 25 from 5:00pm-6:30pm. There will be free snacks and refreshments, balloon animals, games with prizes, and a petting zoo for the entire family to enjoy!
- **Rockmill Weekends 2019**, from 1:00pm-4:00pm May 26, June 30, July 28, August 25, September 29, October 27 (the last Sunday of the month). - Take the entire family to explore an over 100-year-old grist mill, and the beautiful ground and covered bridge surrounding it!
- **Kids and Cops Day at OU-L**, May 18 from 10:00am-2:00pm- Lancaster Citizen Police Academy, Lancaster Police Department, OU-Lancaster, and many others will be present to greet children and teach them all about what Police, Fire, and other agencies do!
- Visit **AHA! Children's Museum**- Open Daily 10:00am-4:00pm. General admission is \$8.00 per person (12 months old and under are free), **Visit a Fairfield County District Library to check out a free pass to spend a day at AHA!**
